

## SINGLE-USE & PLASTIC WASTE PREVENTION REGULATION INFO SHEET

The province of British Columbia rolled out the <u>Single Use & Plastic Waste Prevention Regulation</u> on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2023. The aim of this regulation is to phase out certain hard to recycle single-use plastic items and address waste and pollution in BC.

Regulated Category	Items	Date	Good Alternative	Best Alternative
Disposable Food Service Accessories	Prohibited: Single-use (disposable) plastic utensils Available by request: Wooden utensils, drink cups and sleeves, straws, condiments, napkins	December 20, 2023	*Choose uncoated wood products where possible	Reusable utensils for onsite dining
Shopping Bags	Prohibited: Single-use plastic bags  Fee required: Reusable and paper bags	December 20, 2023  July 15, 2024	Paper bag made with at least 50% post- consumer recycled materials	Reusable shopping bag
Food Service Ware	Prohibited: Single-Use (disposable) food service ware made with hard to recycle plastics such as Styrofoam.	July 15, 2024	Recyclable plastic/aluminum or compostable fibre  *Choose single plastic #1, #5 materials if possible  *Choose unlined, paper/fibre containers	Reusable dishware when dining on-site  Reusable container sharing program for takeouts



Oxo-degradable Plastics	Prohibited: Packaging, or single-use product made partly or completely from oxodegradable or biodegradable plastics which break down into fragments called microplastics.	July 15, 2024	Recyclable plastic made from a single plastic material (#1, #5)  Unlined paper/fibre containers  Aluminum containers with cardboard lid  *Ask supplier for products that meet Association of Plastic Recyclers Guidelines	Reusable dishware when dining on-site  Reusable container sharing program for takeouts
Exemptions	Polyvinyl chloride (PVC) film wrap  Polystyrene foam trays for raw proteins	July 1, 2028  July 1, 2030	Reusable silicone food covers or food bags  Aluminum foil Recyclable plastic trays  *Choose trays that are made with recycled materials	Beeswax Wraps Glass or stainless-steel containers with lids Compostable sugarcane bagasse trays *Ensure no or peelable polythene lining
